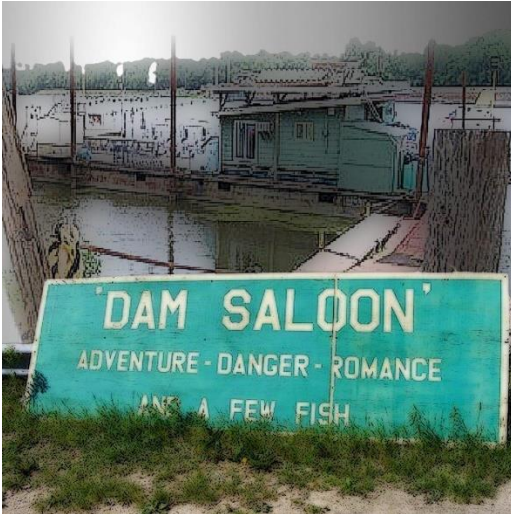


## Local Points of Interest

### **Dam Saloon** (1.4 miles from the house)

The coolest dive bar on the Mississippi floats on an old barge directly below Lock & Dam #5A,



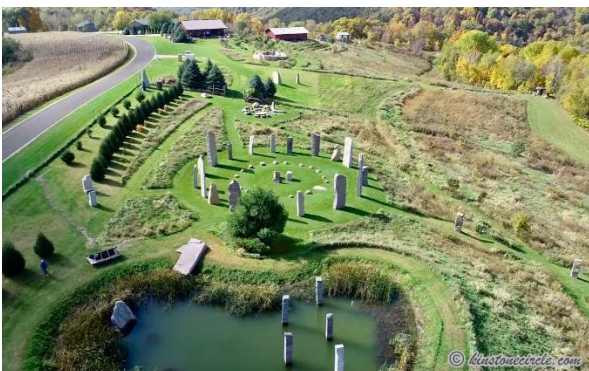
### **Seven Hawks Vineyards** (2.7 miles)

Award winning local wines at this architectural gem tasting room in downtown Fountain City.



### **Kinstone** (5.7 miles)

Wisconsin's very own "Stonehenge," Kinstone is a modern megalithic garden with enormous stones placed throughout this inspiring 30-acre bluff-top property.



### **Bloedow Bakery (5.9 miles)**

No exaggeration, people line up out the door for the best donuts in Minnesota, as found at Bloedow's since 1924.



### **Minnesota Marine Art Museum (6.0 miles)**

From contemporary exhibitions to historic works of art, MMAM engages visitors with great art inspired by water.



### **Hillside Fish House (7.3 miles)**

Classic Wisconsin supper club experience just down the road, capped by an exhaustive menu of grown-up ice cream drinks as big as your head!



**Winona Ice Park (7.6 miles)**

Ice cascades 200 feet down the river bluff face at this magical climbing area free and open to the public.



**Suncrest Gardens Pizza Farm (14.9 miles)**

Wood-fired pizza with ingredients grown on-site, a bottle of wine, live music, farm animals and a u-pick flower garden all make for a perfect summer evening.



**Perrot State Park (15.8 miles)**

500-foot bluffs where the Trempealeau and Mississippi Rivers meet, breathtaking river views from challenging hiking trails, and direct bicycle access to the 24-mile Great River State Trail.



**Buena Vista Park (19.4 miles)**

This city park has the most stunning overlook via the largest natural balcony on the Mississippi River, offering views of barge traffic, sand islands, backwaters, and Lock & Dam #4.
